

CCR Report – Delilah Holmes

Dec 11 Board Meeting:

- The board has received a few easement requests:
 - Fall River Terrace in Harpers Choice
 - Building mixed income apartments
 - Requesting a sidewalk & utility easement- facilities sidewalk improvements and installation of a new multiuse path
 - Private storm drain and utility easement- facilities reconfiguration of existing storm train outfall on CA property and improvements to the pathway
 - South Entrance Trail
 - Request from Howard County Office of Transportation, DPW, Rec & Parks for the south entrance trail, which will be a pathway connection
 - Structured project 63 in the BikeHoward master plan
 - Provides multiuse pathway providing passage under 29 and BLPW bridges
 - 1.0 mile off-road asphalt pathway along LP River
 - Currently missing a bike/pedestrian link between Stevens Forrest and downtown
 - Requesting a total of 3 easements for the project
- 990 approved
- Rate & cap set and staying the same
- Membership rates passed & will increase slightly
- First viewing of draft capital allocation, income, and operating expenses
- Discussed converting one of our outdoor pools to a splash pad.
 - Would be open once frost ends until it starts again—longer than the pools, would be available to anyone; no membership necessary
- Reviewed Q2 financials
